

## 2024-2025 ACTION REPORT

In a time of deepening environmental and social challenges, **Build It Green** pursues bold, community-centered strategies to ensure that how California builds housing advances the wellbeing of both human communities and natural ecosystems. From cultivating the small-scale development sector

and convening changemakers across the state to identify transformative action, to rethinking electrification and funding grassroots innovation, our programs over the last year have supported a shift in residential development toward nurturing people, places, and nature.

### Our priorities in 2024–25 have included:

- Launching the East Bay Small Development Incubator to strengthen the ecosystem essential for building ADUs, small-plexes, and townhomes. This type of development within existing cities and towns is key to meeting California's housing production goals and reducing greenhouse gas pollution by placing homes near transit and jobs.
- Introducing the Builder and Developer Affinity Group to support leaders in the residential development industry who are committed to a holistic approach—addressing California's housing crisis while contributing to both human and environmental vitality.
- Deepening capabilities among changemakers through our Regenerative Communities Program, which helps participants understand the holistic impacts of housing development and develop new approaches to pursue systemic change.
- Investing in transformation through the Innovation Fund, a program in which a committee composed of members from our Housing System Innovators Network awards grants to organizations across the state to carry out cutting-edge research, resource development, and community planning aimed at achieving community and environmental outcomes through housing development.
- Scaling Power Efficient Design through the POWER Group, a collaborative of technical experts working to make home electrification more affordable by avoiding costly electrical upgrades.
- Continuing GreenPoint Rated, our residential green building standard that ensures homes are built to reduce energy use, greenhouse gas emissions, water consumption, and exposure to toxic materials.

Across all efforts, **Build It Green** cultivates partnerships, raises aspirations for transformation in **California's housing system**, and catalyzes ideas that lead to the resources needed for change.
